## EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR MORTGAGE LOAN ORIGINATORS (MLOs)

Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § <u>53-244.070</u>, applicants for a North Carolina MLO license are required to take prelicensure education (PE), which is available through <u>NMLS</u> approved course providers.

## **Prelicensure Education Requirements:**

- 1. Complete a <u>20-hour live classroom</u> or <u>classroom equivalent</u> PE course approved by <u>NMLS</u>.
  - (NOTE to MLO applicants who are licensed in other states: If your 20-hour PE course has not expired (see item 3), you are only required to take the North Carolina specific course (see item 2).)
- 2. Complete a <u>4-hour live classroom</u> or <u>classroom equivalent</u> PE course to meet the North Carolina specific education requirement.
- 3. PE is valid for three (3) years immediately preceding the date of application. N.C. Gen. Stat. § 53-244.050(b)(1)b.

(NOTE: Education <u>must</u> be valid; if your education has expired, you are required to retake it.)
